



5 questions with Chip Wade of HGTV's 'Elbow Room' and 'Curb Appeal: The Block'

Popular HGTV network star Chip Wade is coming to the Southern Ideal Home Show in Raleigh next month.

We asked him to share a few insights about his remodeling and design work on these shows

What are some of the greatest challenges in making a perhaps-too-tight space work for growing families? I have found that the biggest challenges are 1) having too much furniture that doesn't fit the way you actually live and 2) misappropriated storage solutions. Consider consolidating furnishings and replacing with a more multi-national unit, like a table that doubles as a desk or work surface or seating that works for two different spaces. When it comes to storage, it helps to pull everything out and really see what you specifically want to store in a particular space. I recommend building your storage to fit perfectly what you want to store, rather than building generic storage like open shelves that tend to get overpacked when you start with no plan.

What are some of the most common features/rooms/add-ins requested by homeowners who say "there's not enough room!" Typically this request ends up with a remodel that joins the kitchen and living room. Oftentimes it is about finding one space where you can pool square footage together, removing items in that space and creating other storage solutions – leaving a larger gathering-spot free.

What are you most looking forward to about your visit to Raleigh? I love the people of North Carolina! Everyone is always so friendly; it makes it feel like home. It's also close to Atlanta, so I'll get to bring my family as well!



Brie Arthur, edible landscape design correspondent on "Growing A Greener World," will speak at 12:30 p.m. Heather Burgiss, host and producer of "My Home, NC," will speak at 2:30 p.m. Mike Gray, host and producer of the "Almanac Gardener," will speak at 3:30 p.m.
- Discount tickets are available. Tickets cost \$9. All runners participating in the Rock 'n' Roll Raleigh Marathon and Half Marathon can enter for \$5. Just bring race bib to the show to receive discount. On Friday, people who are 55 or older can attend for \$7. Also on Friday, active and former military, police, firefighter or EMT with valid identification can attend for free.

The show is 11 a.m.- 7 p.m. April 8, 10 a.m.-8 p.m. April 9 and 11 a.m.-5 p.m. April 10.
