WILL THERE BE A CHANGE IN AUDIENCE AT THE CHARLOTTE CONVENTION CENTER?

CAN YOU TELL ME ABOUT LOGISTICS AND WHAT TO EXPECT?

The Show is located in Hall A. The Show Office and registration desk is located on the main convention center floor (across from the Starbucks between the elevator and escalator bays). [Click here](#) for a map of the Charlotte Convention Center.

- Move-in: The Convention Center is not a Union facility.

Wednesday, August 24: 3pm-7pm

Thursday, August 25: 9am-7pm

[Loading Details](#) - The loading areas at the Charlotte Convention Center are all inside the building. The Charlotte Convention staff, security and show personnel will monitor and help exhibitors.

- Only vehicles being unloaded or loaded can remain in the loading dock area on Stonewall Street (across from the Westin Hotel parking lot). Look for the Southern Women's Show Sign.
- The Charlotte Convention Center does not provide carts or dollies.
- Only hand-carry items are permissible through the main entrances.
- The Charlotte Convention Center does not have a shipping and receiving department. Any drayage or exhibitor merchandise must be shipped directly to the show decorator.
- Move-out: Sunday, August 28: 5pm-10pm Move out or dismantling is prohibited prior to 5pm on Sunday. For Move Out Exhibitors are advised to pack up all merchandise and proceed to the loading dock gate when instructed. If they need to get personal vehicles, they may do so after they have packed all merchandise.

HOW DO I MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR TECHNICAL NEEDS?

- Free WiFi is available in the large food court seating area and seating area near Starbucks. Instant Internet is also available for \$24.95 per day. Speed to 256K/512K.

• Phone Services

- Standard phone line - \$275.00 (see 3A) see order 5A for phone instrument, no additional equipment charge.

• Electrical 120 Volt Lighting and Utility (Duplex) Outlets

- Standard 5 Amp holds up to 600 watts - \$80.00
- Standard 10 Amp holds up to 1200 watts - \$100.00
- Standard 20 Amp holds up to 2400 watts - \$125.00
